During the second day, the last workshop dedicated to the exploitation of results was organized by the partner **Hub Trentino Innovazione (HIT)**.

A shared document is being prepared to define the strategic steps to be implemented in the months following the end of the project. For example, a sort of technical committee will be created in which the representatives of each of the partners, wishing to join the initiative, will meet, on a regular basis during the first year after the end of the project, to keep the contents of the teaching material updated and make shared decisions on the continuation of the activities.
